

# The St Joseph's Pilgrimage

The St Joseph's pilgrimage is an annual walking pilgrimage organised by the Adelaide Latin Mass Community. This pilgrimage, which is based off the Christus Rex pilgrimage held in Victoria each year, begins in Joanna Hall and finishes at St Joseph's Catholic Church in Penola, covering approximately 40km in 1.25 days. Pilgrims will be accompanied by chaplain Fr Thomas Sofatzis FSSP and Fr Steven McGuckin MC, departing from Holy Name on Fri. 15 March after 8:00am Mass (breakfast supplied) and return Sun, 17 March at approximately 8pm. **Registrations are essential. Please note the following:**

- Some restrictions on numbers may be required (early application suggested)
- Private vehicles not permitted to follow walkers due to safety issues and 4x4 track conditions
- Prams not encouraged due to limited space in trailer and 4x4 track conditions
- Price is all-inclusive and covers transport, meals and accommodation. (Meals in transit at own expense).

- Adult (18 and over): \$200
- Youth (10 to <18yo): \$150
- Child (under 10): \$50
- Infant (under 2yo): Free
